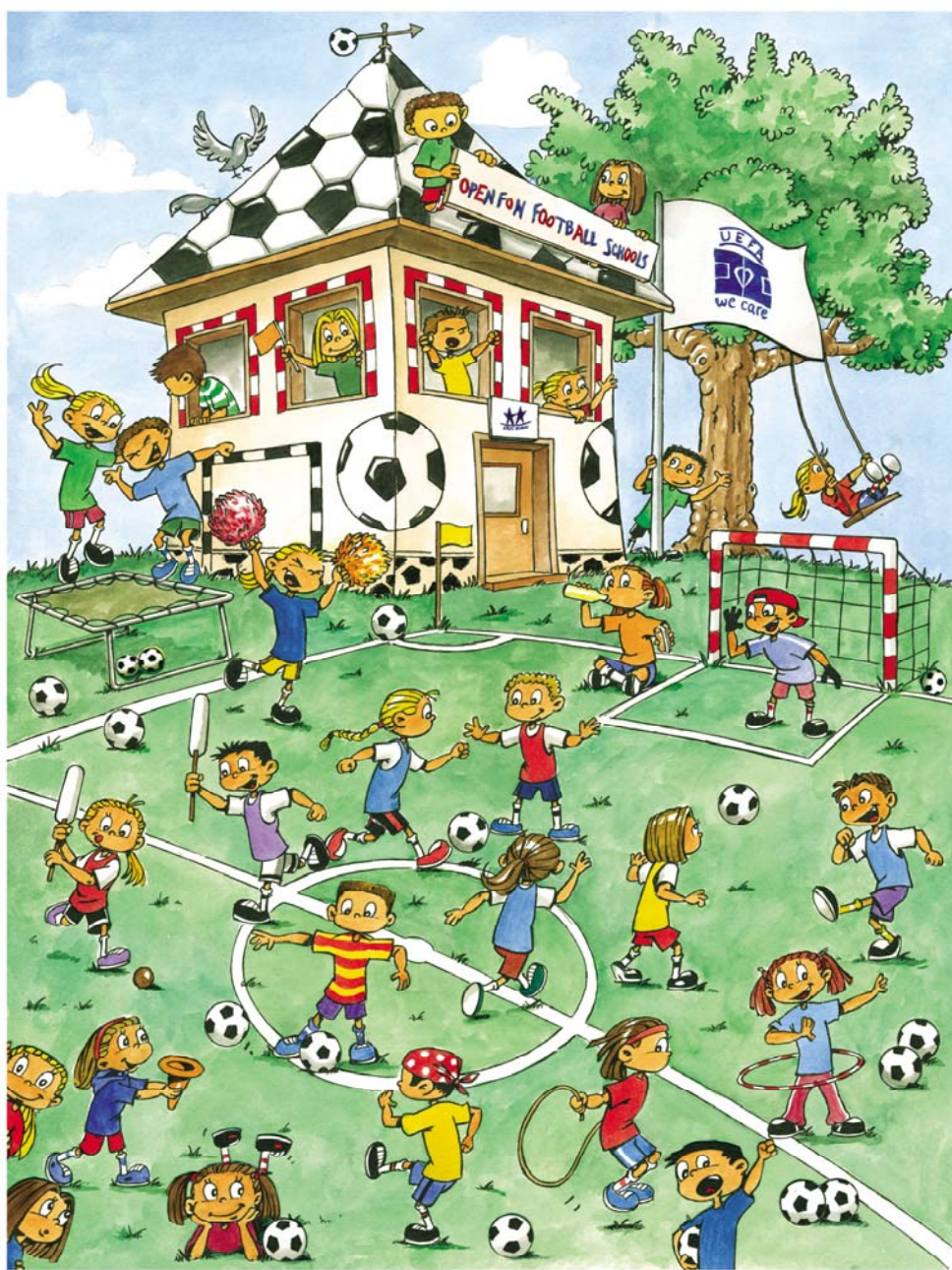

## ABOUT US



Open Fun football Schools is a humanitarian, politically neutral and non profit project, implemented by Cross Cultures Project Association, Copenhagen (CCPA) in cooperation with Norwegian Football Association (NFF).

The Open Fun Football Schools is developed on a concept originating from the Danish Football Association. Its basic idea is a «Fun Concept»: What is important is playful aspect, the joy derived from playing, rather than the results, the core, the advancing skill level. The many exercises and small games are so designed as to make everyone feel successful again and again. During a whole week the kids get to live football, concentrating and immersing themselves completely in the game and the fun.

Open Fun Football Schools must be considered as a supplement of the important work made in football clubs. It is not about developing and harvesting talented players - this we consider as a task of the football organizations and the football clubs - but about giving kids a rich and rewarding experience with ball playing, so as to promote the game recruit players for football and develop their talents.

Using ball games and pure play, Open Fun Football Schools aim to be a strategic instrument in the social and political context re-establishing old but broken friendships and sports cooperating among the football clubs involved, their trainers, leaders and children in all areas we are assigned and thus promoting the issues of tolerance, peaceful coexistence, social cohesion and cooperation between otherwise antagonistic groups.



That is why we have developed our own "Fun Football Concept", where we practice joy and game - joy, to be with the others together, to learn to rule over new details. We are using imagination and fantasy in while playing. Our dreams when playing like Pele, Figo or Zidane, when we wish to dribble cartoon box and try to make our own football training where "ball is considered as a gift" . In other words we are trying to fit in the cooperation and communication element in all our games where the ball is considered as a gift given to the others with a respect in order to make each other better.

That is the way how we have develop our own "Fun Football Concept"

The idea of the CCPA Open Fun Football Schools originates from the Danish summer football schools and from a concept that was conceded by the Danish Football Association to the Open Fun Football schools, introduced first time to the war-torn Bosnia and Herzegovina in 1998.

The aim of this Project of "tolerance" is gathering kids and adults of different ethnical background on dialogue level again.

Since than the project has expanded on Macedonia, Serbia, Monte Negro, Croatia, Georgia, Armenia, Azerbaijan, Moldova, Syria, Jordan, Lebanon and Kosovo.

CCPA Open Fun Football Schools is a huge project no matter of boundaries.

Our Open Fun Football Schools have been based on willingness and voluntarism on all our implemented schools up to 2008. Open Fun Football schools is directed towards supporting the development of the civil society and the strength of the project is to be found in its ability to generate relations between people. Our solid donor platform originates out from Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Nordic Countries - Denmark, Norway, Sweden and Finland together with UEFA, and Novo Nordisk (leading company for

insulin production) that makes our Project economically tenable.

In Macedonia, in the period 2000 - 2008 we have organized 153 Open Fun Football Schools, and a large number of One Day Street Sport Events, and the past eight seasons we have involved almost all the municipalities in Macedonia. Over 33000 boys and girls from the country have participated in our activities, leaded by more than 2300 leaders and coaches - all educated on our regional seminars. For sure that a strong local foundation and support is needed - from Municipalities, Clubs, Cantonal level, Football Associations, Ministry for sports, Private companies and wider local community support.

International Community members are asking from our side to expand local financing - which is needed for trainers / leaders educative expenses on our seminars that we are going to organize in country and in Region.

## **Instructor seminar in Struga, May 20 - 23, 2008**

20-05-2008

The seminar in Struga held on May 20 - 23, was the second instructor seminar this year. And if the first one, organized in Vogosca in January, was mainly focused on the future prospects and development plans of our organization, this second one had more of a practical focus, intending to refresh the exercises that we use in the field and to give us another view and perspective of how we can make our schools even more fun, while in the same time educative.

The participants at the seminar were all the instructors from the Balkan region as well as the employees in the offices, and also one office representative and one instructor from Armenia, Georgia, Azerbaijan and Moldova - having 100 participants in total.

To help us fulfill our plans on the practical side of the exercises, Mr. Horst Wein was invited as one of the lecturers. Given he is one of the most recognized experts on developing game intelligence among the youngest players, it was a true privilege to have him as a demonstrator, but also as a lecturer. He made an excellent theoretical presentation on the newest trends in the development of the football game, putting an accent on the perception, as one of the most important tools in making decisions in a split second while playing on the field. This theoretical presentation was backed up with a practical demonstration on the field, using our instructors in the role of the children, and putting them in position to think rather than just to act accordingly to the instructions of the "Fomador" i.e. the coach.

We have also invited Ms. Lene Terp as our second guest lecturer. What is special about her is that she has played a record number of matches for the Danish Women Football National Team, and was part of the FIFA's all star women selection. But her current occupation is a bit different than her professional football career. She now teaches in a school, and she is an expert in implementing new methods of "learning through playing", respecting the children's differences all along the way. Here practical presentation of the children's games put a smile on all our instructors' faces, and made the seminar more cheerful.

Unfortunately, Mr. Claus Boje wasn't able to participate at the seminar as a lecturer, so that part of the program was fulfilled by the Managing Director of Cross Cultures project Association - Mr. Anders Levinsen. He used this opportunity, while having all the instructors at one place, to remind them of the values and the principals of the Open Fun Football Schools program, of the areas of attention and the importance of the concept of "sport for all". He also stressed that, since we have worked a good way back, working through our eleventh season, the time has come to start thinking of writing our own Open Fun Football Schools book. It is up to this group of people that are part of the Open Fun Football Schools as instructors for several years now, to start thinking of this issue and to give their opinion on the compatibility of what we have seen at the football field during this seminar with the program that we have been successfully implementing so far.

True refreshment at the seminar's program was the "Boxing ring" having Mr. Horst Wein in one corner and Ms. Lene Terp in another. The intention was that the instructors prepare questions for the two of them or to the CCPA head quarters, presented by Mr. Anders Levinsen, which they should answer in the Ring. The atmosphere itself was almost like at a true Boxing Match, having a referee and round announcers, ring, lights and audience, but the "contestants" were very cooperative and in a mood of keeping the high quality of the seminar by giving very professional and thought-through answers on all the questions posed.

At the final seminar day, the instructors took the role of coaches and prepared a display school with more than 230 children from the local area of Ohrid and Struga. This was an excellent opportunity to implement in practice all the new exercises that the instructors saw during the seminar. If the measurement of the success are the smiles on the children's faces, we can freely say that the school and the exercises were a full success. The seminar finished with a summary and a dinner followed up by a party, giving the finish of the seminar somewhat of a festive atmosphere, after which the participants from the Balkan Countries left full with good impressions of having completed an important work, towards the improvement of the Open Fun Football Schools program.

### **Leader seminar in Mavrovo, June 13 - 14, 2008**

13-06-2008

This year's official start of the Open Fun Football Schools season was again marked with the organization of the leader's seminar. This seminar was organized in order to educate the leaders of the schools, that will take place in Macedonia and Kosovo in the season 2008. Except for the leaders, the representatives from the municipalities who have accepted to organize the Open Fun Football Schools this year, also took an active part at the seminar, in order to get a better picture of plan, the working program and basic principals of the Open Fun Football Schools.

The seminar started traditionally, with the organization of the BON BON Cup, right after the arrival of the participants. It's interesting to mention that all the participants took an active role in the BON BON cup, despite of the severe weather conditions, followed by a heavy rain that at moments threatened to interrupt the game and fun. The further part of the program was consisted of a theoretical part, followed up by presentation of the concept of the organization, the structure of the seminar, and welcoming the participants, and the practical part, refreshed with new stations from the instructor seminar in Struga, had to be organized indoors, in the sport hall, due to the bad weather conditions.

The second seminar day was filled with new things in the practical as well as in the theoretical part of the program. In the practical part, there were two new stations that had a task to straighten the communication and the cooperation of the leaders - through a joined construction of mini goals, and making rope figures blindfolded.

There were new program activities in the theoretical part of the program - compared to the programs of the leader's seminars in the previous years. The thing that provoked the idea was the need of specialization of the program in accordance with the needs and the tasks that the leaders need to fulfill during the organization of the Open Fun Football Schools. Having that in mind, we have organized a "boxing ring" where the leaders and the municipality representatives had an opportunity to pose questions to the office and to each other. This working method has proved to be very successful because it provided clarification to several issues regarding the organization of the schools that haven't been completely clarified so far.

Another new part of the program was the leader's documentation - referring to school organization that was thoroughly explained by the office representatives, in the whole hour dedicated to it. Here, the presence of all the leaders was used to explain the importance of the timely submission of all the documentation, for the preparation of the final reports of the project implementation.

Of course, there was also an informal part of the seminar's program followed up with introduction, socialization and exchange of experience among the participants.

Except for the inevitable football matches of the European Championships, followed on the TV programs, the real opportunity for socialization and fun was the dinner organized in the club "Ratract" - followed up with a real disco party.

### **Girls' Football workshop Prilep - March 30, 2008**

#### **Activities:**

The workshop had a program where the active involvement of the participants was highly recommended. Therefore, after the introduction was made by Ms. Aleksandra Nikolovska, on the purpose of the workshop and the program, and after the introduction by the National Coach of the Women's national teams - Mr. Dobre Dimovski, an interactive workshop proceeded.

## **Street event in cooperation with Pro Credit Bank, 12 April, 2008**

Open Fun Football Schools, Macedonia, in cooperation with two branch offices of Pro Credit Bank in municipality Center, have organized a street event on the maxi pitch in the children's home "11 Oktomvri" in Skopje.

100 children that wonderful Saturday morning had an opportunity to do sports, to play and to have fun on the artificial turf pitch in the children's home.

Aside from the sport games that are a part of the Open Fun Football Schools program, the children had an opportunity to get familiar with the children savings program of Pro Credit Bank, having it presented on a separate station by the employees in the bank, and using fun stories and games as a tool.

The work on the sport stations was organized by the experienced instructors, leaders and trainers from the Open Fun Football Schools, Macedonia, and the assistants were the students from the high school "Nikola Karev", Skopje - ones that have chosen sport as their project activity.

60 children from III and IV grade from the primary School "Johan Hajnrh Pestaloci" from the center of Skopje took part on the event, and they were accompanied by their peers from the Primary School "Rajko Zinzifov" from Dracevo and from P.S. "Dimitar Pop Georgiev Berovski" from Gjorce Petrov.

Following the tradition and the principals of Open Fun Football Schools, 30% of the participants at the event were girls, and many of the children were accompanied by their parents and school teachers. Through brochures and leaflets all the adults present had a chance to be introduced to the work of Open Fun Football Schools in Macedonia and to the program of children's saving of Pro Credit Bank. They all saluted the event, hoping that similar activities will be organized in some of the following weekends.

The children that are living in the home also took part, which once again reminded us how important is the role of the donation of the pitch by the Norwegian Government and in cooperation with the Open Fun Football Schools and the Football Federation of Macedonia.

## **Seminar project "Healthy Children - Healthy Environment", 19-20.04.2008**

For the implementation of the project „Healthy Children - Healthy Environment “ in cooperation of the Open Fun Football Schools, the American Embassy in Skopje, the Agency of Youth and Sports of R.Macedonia we have organized an education seminar including themes from sports-ecological character in h. Negorski Banji in Negorci,

Participants on this seminar were 37 teachers from PS "Manus Turnovski" Novo Selo- Strumica, the primary schools from Gjorce Petrov, Kisela Voda, Spoiste and Cair, representatives from the Peace Corps, as well as lecturers from the NGO OXO and the Open Fun Football Schools.

The seminar passed in great atmosphere, putting an accent on the improvement of the quality of the approach of the teachers towards their pupils and setting free the children's personality . The teachers all filled with positive energy actively participated in the practical stations and the workshops giving their input in the quality of the contents of the seminar.

The games were never-ending through the „fun” concept of the Open Fun Football Schools, and all the participants have woken up the child inside, socializing with their colleagues and at the same time giving quality suggestions for the implementation of the future activities with the pupils from III to IV grade that will participate on these sport events. Besides the small games, the participants had the opportunity to get to know the rules of the baseball game, and the seminar program also included lecture with environmental- ecological character done by the representative of the NGO OXO, at the same time presenting the printed materials used in the presentation of their activities.

The results achieved on this are excellent, and we are sure that the future event will be organized by quality people using enormous creativity when working with the children.

## **Sport events Novo Selo and Skopje- May, 2008**

The implementation of project Healthy Children – Healthy Environment which was prepared with the cooperation of the American Embassy in Skopje , the Agency of Youth and Sports of Macedonia and the Open Fun Football Schools , involved organization of sport-ecological activities. These activities took place in Novo Selo and Skopje in May, 2008 and the main goal was education through sport activities and by learning to cherish the environment and the closest surroundings.

### **1. Events in Novo Selo, May 7 and 8, 2008**

The preparation of the events in Novo Selo started with a meeting with the coaches that were all teachers in the central Primary School - Manush Turnovski, and from the Primary School - Marshal Tito from Bansko. Two volunteers from the Peace Corps also joined the implementation of the program in the part of the Baseball tutoring.

The event on May 7 took part at the open market in Novo Selo, as an alternative place because of the massive rain falls that day that disabled the implementation at the playing field of the Primary School, and the fact that more than 160 children coming from 8 villages were gathered under these conditions, showed that the friendship and fun have no limit, and the activities were implemented in the most perfect way.

The event on May 8 took part at the football field in the Sushica village, in a great atmosphere and in perfect weather conditions. The playing field was in excellent condition and the weather much better than the day before. Although most of the coaches are involved in an Open Fun Football Schools activity for the first time, they had an excellent performance on the field.

### **2. Event in Skopje May 10, 2008**

The event day in Skopje started with gathering of 160 children at the ARM football stadium. The children came from 11 different primary schools. The activities were according to the same program implemented in Novo Selo and also included activities in the amusement park where they had free rides on all the rides.

### **3. Joined event in Skopje May 11, 2008**

The activities on the joined event day have started with the gathering of all the participants from Skopje and the region of Novo Selo at the Bank of the river Vardar, next to the Alexander Palace Hotel. The event has started with a walk alongside the river and picking garbage by the children participants, from where the children from Novo Selo proceeded to the amusement park, and the children from Skopje went to the stadium for the warm-up. After the activities in the park finished all 320 children were joined together at 14 stations at the ARM football stadium. The activities at the stations were guided by the joined efforts of the coaches from Skopje and Novo Selo, in a perfect harmony.

Worth mentioning is that 20 high school children from the Gymnasium Nikola Karev, Skopje, that have chosen sport as their project activity, have joined the program as volunteer assistants on the stations on the Saturday and Sunday in Skopje.

Additionally to the program at the stations there was a baseball match organized on the football pitch of FC “Rabotnicki” - situated next to the ARM football field were 20 children from Novo Selo and Bansko, from the seventh and eighth grades that arrived together with their coaches to show how the game is played.

And finally on this day more than 400 participants showed their preparation to learn, play and cherish the environment through new friendships.

## **EDUCATION CLASSES IN THE NATURE May 12. - 16.2008**

On May 12. - 16. 2008 in the frames of the lectures intended for 102 pupils from second to fourth grade in the primary school „ Kliment Ohridski “ from Skopje with cooperation of the T.A. APEX FOUR from Skopje, had implemented specially prepared program. This program consisted of education classes implemented in the nature where the pupils had the opportunity to gain new knowledge in the field of geography, history, nature and sports in one practical way, socializing through all the contents.

The classes took place in the hotel Negorski Banji, Negorci , where the sports part consisted of small games from the Open Fun Football Schools program using the fun concept or learning through games and fun.

The children were organized and lead by three excellent students of the Faculty of Physical Culture in Skopje, who at the same time are volunteers in the Open Fun Football Schools. The students have answered this assignment organizing the activities in the most professional way being excellently accepted by the children.

The impressions that the children had were so strong, that all the children were writing in the school about their impressions and the fun they had with their friend, teachers and trainers at the football stadium in Negorski Banji, asking their parents to allow them to participate again on such events.

The players and the children supporters of the event were greeted by the Mayor of the municipality Mr. Sokol Mitrevski, the president of the council in the municipality, the football stars Boban Babunski, Georgi Hristov, and the well known and most famous between the children the television star Ljupco Karov – Cacko.

The tournament took place at the football stadium Makedonia, where the boys and girls were playing in the teams, and the entertaining program was lead by groups of children coming from the schools.

The fun spirit was present all the time, and the children were leaving the game together with their favorite teams. The football pitch was rumbling by the sports spirit when more 1500 player and children watching the game, were cheering the beautiful football anthem Macedonia is cheering for you!!

## **NIKE FOR GOALS, 08.11.2008**

Open Fun Football School in cooperation with Delta Sport – Macedonia and the F.C Forca, F.C. Makedonia-Gjorce Petrov, F.C. Ilinden, F.S. Kiril Petrosevski – Volkovo, F.C. Tefejjuz, F.C. Rabotnicki, F.C. Alumina, F.C. Skopsko Pole, F.C. Dracevo, F.C. Gorska Kids Fudbal, has organized a football tournament that took place on the football pitch of the football club Alumina – in Skopje on the 08.11.2008, starting from 10:00 o'clock. Participants on the tournament NIKE FOR GOALS were 190 children, generations 1997 and 1998 that played in two rounds. The first round was played by the generation 1997, and the second round by the children generation 1998.

For the organization of this tournament the football pitch was split in 8 stations each containing 4 goals, and rotations of the teams after every match. The children coming from the clubs were mixed together, and then split into new teams having the opportunity to meet and cooperate with new friends. All the children participants wore different marker t-shirts making the pitch even more colorful.

The matches were full with the spirit of fun and fair play and there were over 300 goals scored during the matches. The tournament was promoting the development of the team spirit, respect through games and fun, and it was played according to the principals of Open Fun Football School, where every child had the opportunity to feel how it is to be a part of a winning team.

This competition was organized thanks to the great collaboration that Open Fun Football School has with the football clubs and schools, who's trainers have also participated the trainer education organized by the Open Fun Football School.

This event was a real sensation for all the children, who wanted to find out when will be the next opportunity to be a part of such an event.

## **PET collection – sport event 15/11/2008**

In line with the plastic recycling project support by USAID and PUC “Komunalna Higiena”, Open Fun Football Schools took part as implementers of the sport activities for children that were part of the campaign for PET collection.

After the first event for the schools from the municipality Gjorce Petrov, an event for approximately 200 children (76 girls and 119 boys) at the age of 9 to 11 was organized on the sport fields of the “Nikola Karev” High School in Skopje. The purpose of organizing this tournament was to do a follow up on the workshop of girls' football that OFFS Macedonia organized in cooperation with the Football Federation of Macedonia in March, 2008. Part of the regions that took part at this tournaments had OFFS trainers and leaders that were provoked to start a girls team either by the workshop or by the Open Fun Football Schools in general. Few regions haven't yet started the process of training girls, but are intending to do so as the interest among the girls have proven to be big.

In total, out of 82 girls participating, 39 were 5<sup>th</sup> graders and 43 were 6<sup>th</sup> graders in primary schools; 42 were Macedonian, 13 Turkish, 7 Roma, 13 Albanian and 7 were Serbian.

The tournament was organized on the principals of Open Fun Football Schools, which means that the teams were mixed from different regions, and once again we have used the Horst Wein methodology of playing on four goals, and rotating the players in order to give them a chance, first of all to meet and play with as many new friends as possible, and second, of scoring as many goals as possible. The ground was divided in three playing pitches that enabled three games with six teams participating to be played at the same time. In total 21 mini matches were played, and 137 goals were scored that gave most of the participants an opportunity to score and be a part of the winning team!!!!

After the tournament finished part of the girls went to see the Handball Match between Denmark and Hungary where all the girls dressed in Open Fun Football Schools marker T-shirts cheered for Denmark...
